Nebraska Department of Environmental and Energy – In accordance with Nebraska Administrative Code Title 124 Rules and Regulations for the Design, Operation and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems, Chapter 20, 009 – has approved all the on demand sessions for the WWETT 2021 Continuing Education On-Demand, **except those listed below**.

### PDH Process:

- Register for the WWETT online education package. Indicate you are accredited through Nebraska Title 124 in the continuing education portion of the registration and include your license number.
- Watch as many recordings/sessions as you want. They are available from August 17 through October 31.
- At the end of each session there will be a quiz. You must pass the quiz to receive a certificate of completion.
- Certificate of completion will be available immediately upon passing the quiz. **Please download and/or print your certificate. This is an online platform that will not store your certificates after October 31. The WWETT Show will not have access to your certificates.**
- The WWETT Show will send Nebraska Title 124 the records of sessions you watched and passed the quiz.
