



Continuing Education Information

Ohio Department of Health has approved up to 18 hours of continuing education (CE) for sewage treatment system contractors, including installers, septage haulers and service providers for online-sessions for attending the WWETT 2021 Continuing Education On Demand. Each session included in the education tracks is approved to the nearest one-half contact hour.

Courses **not approved** for CE hours for the STS Contractors:

CE Process:

- Register for the WWETT online education package. Indicate you are accredited through Ohio DOH in the continuing education portion of the registration and include your license number.
- Watch as many recordings/sessions as you want. They are available from August 17 through October 31.
- At the end of each session there will be a quiz. You must pass the quiz to receive a certificate of completion.
- Certificate of completion will be available immediately upon passing the quiz. **Please download and/or print your certificate. This is an online platform that will not store your certificates after October 31. The WWETT Show will not have access to your certificates.**
- As a courtesy, the WWETT Show will send Ohio DOH the records of sessions you watched and passed the quiz.
- Conference attendees from Ohio may apply credits for each session/course attended to the 2022 registration year to meet the requirement set forth in Ohio Administrative Code 3701-29-03 (C)(5). It is the responsibility of the sewage treatment system contractor to maintain records of CE hours earned and provide proof to each board of health at the time of registration.
