



Continuing Education Information

Ohio Department of Health has approved up to 18 hours of continuing education (CE) for sewage treatment system contractors, including installers, septage haulers and service providers. Each session included in the education tracks offered on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday is approved to the nearest one-half contact hour.  - Attendee will download or print earned certificates to use as proof of CE hours.
