**\*\*\* The NAWT and PSAI Certification Courses have been approved for six (6) CEUs with the following stipulation. These courses do not replace the required application and testing process for certification in Kentucky.** Each attendee (that chooses to become certified to install systems in Kentucky) must still make application and pass the Onsite Sewage Disposal Systems Test which is given through their local county health department in Kentucky or the Frankfort, Kentucky office.

CEU Process:

- WWETT will submit your attendance to Kentucky Department for Public Health if you do the following:
  - **Register for each session (preselect your classes) you want credit for and get scanned at the door. Register + scan = proof of attendance/receive credit.**
  - Include your certification number when you register for the show on the Continuing Education page.
  - Provide the last four digits of your social security number on a sign in sheet outside the door of your first session. (This is necessary only once – not for each session you attend.)
- An email notification will be sent approximately six weeks post show with instructions to download your certificates of completion.
- Attendee will download or print earned certificates and keep on file for your own records.
