



Continuing Education Information

Ohio Department of Health has approved up to 15.5 hours of continuing education (CE) for sewage treatment system contractors, including installers, septage haulers and service providers. Each session included in the education tracks offered on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday is approved to the nearest one-half contact hour **WITH THE EXCEPTION OF The Women in the Industry Mixer and the New to The Industry Mixer.** Additional approved stand-alone courses have been approved and are listed below.

Session approvals as follows:

- Wednesday, January 24 – up to 6.0 hours
- Thursday, January 25 – up to 5.5 hours
- Friday, January 26 – up to 4.0 hours

Stand-alone courses also approved

- Wednesday, January 24 – Confined Space Entry – 4.0 hours
- Thursday, January 25 – Digital Marketing Workshop – 3.25 hours
- Friday, January 26 – NOWRA Training – 6.0 hours
- Friday, January 26 – Sewer Cleaning 102 – 8.0 hours

CE Process:

- **Attendee must be registered for each session they want credit for and scanned at the door to receive certificates of completion.**
- The WWETT Show will send your attendance to Ohio Department of Health as a courtesy.
- Conference attendees from Ohio may apply credits for each session/course attended to the 2025 registration year to meet the requirement set forth in Ohio Administrative Code 3701-29-03 (C)(5). It is the responsibility of the sewage treatment system contractor to maintain records of CE hours earned and provide proof to each board of health at the time of registration.
 - An email notification will be sent approximately six weeks post show with instructions to download your certificates of completion. Attendee will download or print earned certificates to use as proof of CE hours.
